## WHILE IN/ENTERING THE BUILDING



- Everyone must wear face coverings/masks at all times while in the building
- Hand sanitizer must be used upon entry and is provided in each studio
- Studios, instruments, and equipment are sanitized between every lesson or class
- Designated waiting places for students are spaced out at least 6 ft apart

## STAFF SCREENING



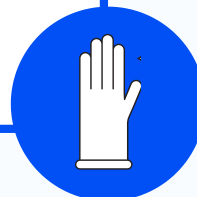
- AMDC screens all employees and takes their temperatures before each shift

## MUSIC LESSONS

- Rooms are divided in half with teacher on one side and student on the other
- Plexiglass dividers are placed between teachers and students
- If students need an instrument tuned, the teachers will wear gloves
- Student enter and exit through front door

## ROCK BAND CLASSES

- 6ft distancing between students and teachers
- Vocalists are behind a partition & use their own personal microphone
- Students enter and exit through the back door

## DANCE CLASSES

- Students and teachers has a 10ft X 10ft space for dancing
- Every student has a personal ballet bar
- Students enter and exit through back door
